FAQs

SECTION	DETAILS
When will the competition open?	Registration opens on the official launch date. The artwork submission portal will open separately according to the official competition timeline announced by the Organiser.
Who is eligible to participate?	The competition is open to students aged 17–22 years old who are currently enrolled in a recognised secondary school, college, university, polytechnic, or equivalent educational institution in Malaysia.
How do I register?	Complete the online Participant Registration Form before the registration deadline. Registration is compulsory before submitting your artwork.
How do I submit my artwork?	Only registered participants may access the online Artwork Submission Form during the official submission period. Participants are required to submit one (1) original digital artwork, an Artwork Title, and a brief Artist Statement.
What are the artwork submission requirements?	Participants must submit one (1) original digital artwork, an Artwork Title, and an Artist Statement (maximum 200 words) explaining the inspiration, concept, and how the artwork reflects the competition theme.
What are the artwork specifications?	Artwork must be created in A2 size (420 × 594 mm), in either portrait or landscape orientation, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi, RGB colour mode, and submitted in JPG or PNG format with a maximum file size of 10 MB.
What types of artwork are accepted?	Completed digital artworks, including Digital Illustration, Digital Painting, Character Design, Comic Illustration, Concept Art, Vector Illustration, Digital Collage, Poster Design, and other original digital artwork formats.
What should I include in my Artist Statement?	Your Artist Statement (maximum 200 words) should briefly explain the inspiration behind your artwork, the creative concept, and how it represents the competition theme, <i>"Malaysia Through My Eyes."</i>
Where can I find the Competition Guidelines?	The Competition Guidelines & Terms and Conditions are available for download on the official competition website. Please read them carefully before registering or submitting your artwork.
Can I edit or replace my submission?	No. Once an artwork has been submitted, it cannot be edited, replaced, or withdrawn. Please review your submission carefully before submitting.

Can I submit more than one artwork?	No. Each participant may submit one (1) original digital artwork only.
What prizes can I win?	The competition will recognise one Junior Champion and one Senior Champion, together with selected Special Awards. Prize details will be announced by the Organiser.
Will I receive a certificate?	Yes. All eligible participants who successfully submit a valid artwork in accordance with the Competition Guidelines & Terms and Conditions will receive an E-Certificate of Participation. The Junior Champion, Senior Champion, and recipients of the Special Awards will also receive their respective award certificates in addition to any prizes offered by the Organiser.
Where can I view the competition timeline?	The latest Competition Timeline is available on the official competition website. Registration dates, submission deadlines, public voting, judging, and winner announcements will be updated as they are confirmed. Participants are encouraged to check the website and the official @ypccreatives social media channels regularly for the latest information. Please note that all dates are <i>subject to change</i> at the Organiser's discretion. Any changes will be announced through the official competition communication channels.
When will the winners be announced?	Winners will be announced according to the official competition timeline on the competition website and the @ypccreatives social media channels.
